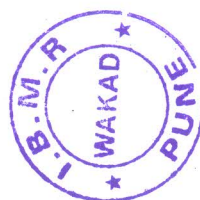
Alumni feedback on Current Syllabus


