More than 90 per cent of the respondent gave opinion that the syllabi were appropriate and explained clearly. Board of study is also taking care to ensure the relevance in the programme offering and the system followed by the University for design and development of curriculum is effective. While 50 per cent respondent agreed that they have given enough freedom to contribute their ideas on curriculum design and a development through participation in syllabus restructures and design Seminars. While more than 91 per cent faculties were agreed on the point that employability is given weightage in curriculum. All the faculty members were agreed on the point that the curriculum has been updated from time to time.

Parent's Feedback on the Current Syllabus

The Savitribai Phule Pune University changed the Syllabi of MBA programme in the academic year 2016-2017. Therefore, in 2018 the Institute decided to take the feedback on current Syllabi from the parents. There is only one MBA course running the Institute so the IQAC decided to choose 10 parents from MBA I st Year and the 5 parents For MBA II nd year. The Sample Size for the feedback was 10. The data were collected with the help of a structured questionnaire.

More than 88 per cent of the respondents positively responded that the curriculum took their ward's academic and professional needs into account, syllabi contained a statement of objectives, they could understand the objectives in terms of their learning outcomes, the contents of the syllabi matched the child's academic interest/ aptitude, the curriculum would provide job opportunities to the wards. About 70 per cent of the respondents felt that there was a need to revise the syllabus.

However, 30 per cent of the respondents complained about some aspects of the syllabi and also found that the topics in the syllabi were too limited/vast.
